OPEN ENROLLMENT

Enrollment in the virtual schools is made available to Northern Ozaukee School District's resident students during the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction's open enrollment period each February. The option for non-resident students after the open enrollment period is tuition. The program is available to resident Northern Ozaukee School District students any time during the school year.

IMPORTANT TO NOTE

Virtual schools are not a viable option for all students. It is a program that requires self-discipline and parents or guardians who have a desire to be involved in their son's or daughter's education. It is important to study the program and delivery model before enrolling in the school.
