## MISSION

## ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PROFILE

Ozaukee Elementary School is a six-year, comprehensive, academic elementary school, serving preschool through grade 4. The kindergarten program is a full-day offering. The school is located in Fredonia, Wisconsin, approximately 30 miles north of Milwaukee on Highway 57, and approximately 10 miles east of Lake Michigan. The school is fully authorized by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction.

## ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CURRICULUM

The curriculum taught at Ozaukee Elementary is based on high-quality local, state, and national standards, and is delivered through best teaching practices that are supported by a process of continuous review and improvement.

Ozaukee Elementary offers half-day four-year-old kindergarten (preschool) five days per week. The program is play-based and developmentally appropriate, focusing on social/emotional and academic readiness skills.

A full-day program is provided for five-year-old kindergarten through fourth grade students. The curriculum includes language arts (reading, writing, spelling, listening, speaking, and handwriting), mathematics, social studies, science, art, music, physical education, library, and computer literacy.

Ozaukee Elementary is a **Positive Action School**. *Positive Action* is a whole-school, comprehensive program designed to promote total wellness, competency, and healthy lifestyles in individuals.

Students have access to network computers in every classroom, computer lab, Internet access, SMARTboards, and school Web site.

## PARENT INVOLVEMENT

Parent involvement is strongly encouraged at Ozaukee Elementary School. Each family has a **Family Access** account. This account allows parents to view grades, missing assignments, food/snack purchases, attendance, and more. Ask about the details at the appropriate office.
