MISSION

Ozaukee High School will foster a culture of learning that builds an academic, personal, social, and career foundation for each student.

HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE

Ozaukee High School is a four-year, comprehensive, public high school, housing grades 9, 10, 11, and 12. The school is located in Fredonia, Wisconsin, approximately 30 miles north of Milwaukee, on Highway 57 and approximately 10 miles west of Lake Michigan. The school is fully authorized by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction. The school has a composite ACT score of 22.6 and students score above the state average for the state assessment annually.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Ozaukee High School uses a credit system and requires 27 credits for graduation.
2. All students in grades 9-12 take five classes each trimester. Period six is either band and/or choir or a study hall (SEA time). If a student is in band or choir, a study hall may be taken. Students must be in school all periods each day, unless they are enrolled in programs approved by the principal, the Board representative.
3. Course credit value: One-half credit courses meet every day for one trimester (12 weeks), one-credit courses meet every day for two trimesters (24 weeks), and 1½-credit courses meet every day, all year (36 weeks).
